TO: SENIORS (PLEASE TAKE HOME)

Scholarship applications requiring an official high school transcript, counselor letter of recommendation or counselor's signature must be submitted to your school counselor at least 14 days prior to the due date. In addition to the scholarships listed here, most colleges offer available scholarships when students apply to their school. Please contact the prospective colleges directly to inquire about scholarships.

Hudson Mohawk - AHEC:

This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to graduating high school seniors who have a strong desire to further their education in the healthcare industry. Application is available in the Counseling Office. The deadline is May 1, 2017.

The Lawrence Madeiros Memorial Scholarship:

Applicant must be graduating from high school in the year of the scholarship award, be diagnosed with a bleeding disorder or other chronic disorder and accepted at a college/university. A limited number of applications are available in the Counseling Office. The deadline to apply is May 1, 2017.

The Nick Birchak Strength of Character College Scholarship & The Epilepsy Foundation of Northeastern NY Scholarship:

Both scholarships will be awarded \$1000 each to students who are currently being treated for epilepsy and have plans to further their education. For an application and more information visit the Counseling Office. The deadline is May 5, 2017.

CSEA 2017 Daniel X Campbell Memorial Scholarship:

To be eligible for this award, the applicant must meet the following criteria: be a 2017 high school graduate, a parent or guardian who is a member of CSEA's Capital Region and accepted to an accredited institution of higher education in New York State. The deadline to apply is May 10, 2017. Applications are available in the Counseling Office.

Albany County/Local 801 George Sheffield Memorial Scholarship:

To be eligible for this \$1250 scholarship, student must be a child of a CSEA Local 801 member in good standing, a senior graduating in June, have at least an 80% GPA and show proof of acceptance to a two or four year college, university or trade school. The deadline to apply is May 10, 2017. Applications are available in the Counseling Office.

Capital Region Golf Course Owners Association Scholarship:

Scholarships awarded to a student(s) who has shown interest in golf either through being on a high school golf team, been in the NENYJR PGA Association or participating in the sport of golf in his/her teenage years. The criteria is as follows: have a sincere interest in golf, commitment to study in a particular school and be goal oriented. For more information stop into the Counseling Office. The deadline is June 1, 2017.

NY-PENN League Charitable Foundation 2017 Scholarship:

To be eligible the student must be graduating senior, minimum GPA of a 3.0, demonstrate leadership, community service, extracurricular activities and the impact the applicant's local NYPL franchise has had on his/her life. For more information stop into the Counseling Office. The deadline is June 5, 2017.

WORKSHOPS, EDUCATION, VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES & CONTESTS:

The New York State Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) Incentive Program:

A full SUNY or CUNY tuition scholarship for the top ten percent of students in each New York State high school if they pursue a STEM degree in an associate or bachelor degree program and agree to work in a STEM field in New York State for five years after graduation. Applications for current high school seniors will be available starting in January 2017.
