Dear Parents,


I am writing to let you know that we conducted a formal lockdown drill today, Feb. 12, in all of our school buildings. The drill was conducted by the New York State Police and the Town of Stillwater Police Department. The event lasted approximately 15 minutes, during which time both school buildings went into complete lockdown in accordance with the district's emergency plan.

All school staff and students responded appropriately during the drill.

Lockdown drills are part of Stillwater's effort to ensure that staff members are trained in how to act during a potential emergency and to give students practice opportunities. We will continue to practice informal drills throughout the school year, as they are an important way for us to improve our protocols and procedures.
