

### A GLIMPSE OF STILLWATER STUDENT SUCCESS

#### **Academic Achievements**

- In 2013-14, Stillwater's graduation rate was 94 percent, which is more than 15 percentage points higher than the state average. And among those Stillwater graduates, 90 percent went on to a two- or four-year college.
- Sixty-three percent of Stillwater students who take Advanced Placement (AP) exams score at a level 3 or better (level 5 is the highest possible score).
- Stillwater was named an Apple Distinguished Program for its implementation of the 1:1 iPad Program. This selection highlights the district's successes in enhancing and extending teaching and learning with innovative implementations of technology.

#### **Art, Music & Drama Achievements**

■ Students in grades 3-12 have the opportunity to participate

in New York State School Music Association (NYSSMA) solos and band performances each year. A number of Stillwater students routinely score an "outstanding" or "excellent" ranking at the spring NYSSMA festival.

- More than 30 elementary students and approximately 20 middle school students took to the stage to perform musicals this spring.
- Each year Stillwater High School student work is selected for publication in the WSWHE BOCES regional art/literacy magazine.



## & Athletic **Achievements**

- Approximately 75 percent of students at Stillwater High School participate in an interscholastic sport or after-school club.
- Approximately 62 percent of students in grades 7 and 8 participate in a school sport or after-school activity.
- More than 250 elementary students participated in Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math (STEAM) after-school enrichment opportunities, such as robotics, Odyssey of the Mind, Warrior TV and Service Club.
- Stillwater Elementary's Odyssey of the Mind team advanced to the New York State Odyssey of the Mind Competition in April 2015.
- For the first time in Stillwater history, the Boys' Varsity Indoor Track Team was named Sectional Champions in February 2015.
- Fourteen (14) Stillwater teams received NY State Public High School Athletic Association Scholar-Athlete Awards in the 2014-15 school year. To achieve this, team members must collectively have a GPA of 90 percent or higher.
